

## Supervisors of the Checklist, 2012 Webster, NH

The Checklist is a list of all registered voters for any given city or town in New Hampshire. With very few exceptions, the contents of the Checklist are public information. Copies of Webster's Checklist are posted at the Town Office and the Public Safety building.

The Supervisors of the Checklist meet periodically to make updates and corrections to the Checklist. All Supervisor meetings are held in the Town Offices or Town Hall and are open to the public.

In accordance with RSA 654:39, the Supervisors verified the checklist in 2011, and anyone who had not voted within the previous four years was removed. ***These persons were notified by mail that they must re-register to vote again.***

Potential voters may fill out a Voter Registration form at the Town Clerk's office or may register directly with the Supervisors at any time they are in session.

To register, the applicant must provide proof of identity, age, citizenship, and domicile, such as a NH driver's license, NH vehicle registration, or passport. For naturalized citizens, the applicant must also provide the date and name of court where naturalization occurred.

A registering voter selects a party affiliation (Democrat or Republican) or is Undeclared. Undeclared voters must declare a party to receive a ballot for federal or state ***primary*** elections. These voters will remain affiliated with that party until they request a change to their voter affiliation. Voter affiliation can be changed only at designated times.

### Polling Places

Federal, State, Town, and Pillsbury Lake District elections are held at the Town Hall, 945 Battle Street, Webster.

School Board elections and the School Warrant (budget) Meeting are held at Merrimack Valley High School, 106 Village Street, Penacook.

### Important Dates (last updated December 14, 2011)

The following list contains important dates for changing the Checklist. Other dates and times will be posted as the Supervisors are made aware of them. These will be posted on the town website and the bulletin boards.

**January 3, 2012** – Supervisors of the Checklist meet 7:00-7:30 pm to accept new registrations and to make changes to the Checklist. ***No change to party affiliation will be accepted before the Presidential Primary.***

**January 10, 2012 – Presidential Primary: Town Hall, 8 am to 7 pm.** The Supervisors may accept new registrations on Election Day. Undeclared voters must select a party to obtain a ballot. ***Only*** Undeclared voters may change their party affiliation again after they have cast their ballot.

## Supervisors of the Checklist, 2012 Webster, NH

**January 24, 2012** – Supervisors meet 7:00-7:30 pm to accept new registrations and to make any changes to the Checklist.

**February 20, 2012** – Supervisors meet 7:00-8:00 pm to accept new registrations and to make any changes to the checklist prior to the School District elections and business meeting.

**March 3, 2012** – Supervisors meet 11:00-11:30 am to accept new registrations and to make any changes to the Checklist prior to the Town Election.

**March 8, 2012** – **Merrimack Valley School District Annual Meeting, MVHS. Polls are open 6 pm - 7:30 pm; Meeting starts at 7 pm.** Election of School Board members and review/adoption of the Warrant, including the school budget. Supervisors will accept new registrations.

**March 13, 2012** – **Town Election Day: Town Hall, 10 am to 7 pm.** The Supervisors may accept new registrations on Election Day. They may also accept requests for other changes, including party affiliation.

**March 14, 2012** – **Pillsbury Lake District Election and Meeting, Town Hall. Polls are open 6:30 pm – 8:00 pm; Meeting starts at 7 pm.** Only registered residents of the district may vote. Supervisors will accept new registrations.

**March 17, 2012** – **Town Hall Meeting. Meeting starts at 10 am.**

**June 5, 2012** – Supervisors meet 7:00-7:30 pm to accept new registrations and to make any changes to the Checklist. ***This is the last day to change party affiliation before the State Primary in September.***

**September 4, 2012** – Supervisors meet 7:00-7:30 pm to accept new registrations and to make changes to the Checklist ***except for*** party affiliation.

**September 11, 2012** – **State Primary Election Day: Town Hall, 8 am to 7 pm.**

**October 27, 2012** – Supervisors meet 11:00-11:30 am to accept new registrations and to make any changes to the Checklist.

**November 6, 2012** – **General Election Day: Town Hall, 8 am to 7 pm.** Supervisors may accept new registrations on Election Day.
