4:16 pm Selectmen's Meeting – April 19, 2013 – Work Session

Selectmen present: Chairman Bruce Johnson and Selectman Mason Donovan.

Chairman Johnson advised that the purpose of this meeting was to meet with Tom Baye to discuss the position of Life Safety Code Enforcement Officer.

The Board discussed the ongoing issues outstanding with Mr. Baye. Chairman Johnson took Mr. Baye's e-mail address and will forward him Tom Godfrey's e-mail address so that the two can meet to work on the transfer of responsibilities.

Selectman Donovan inquired about time issues, which Mr. Baye indicated he had plenty of time to attend to the job and would make time as his business is currently very slow. Mr. Baye advised that he does the building inspections for Warner as well.

The Board discussed the possibility of a "conflict of interest" should Mr. Baye do building construction in Webster. Mr. Baye recommended having someone else do those inspections, saying that Peter Wyman from Warner does those inspections in Warner that Mr. Baye works on. He recommended that Webster use him as well, which seemed amenable to all.

The payment fee schedule was provided to Mr. Baye, to which he was agreeable. Selectman Donovan advised that he was in the process of reviewing all the fees charged by the Town; therefore there may be some changes. They discussed the forms to be used, new and old.

Chairman Johnson advised that Therese Larson will be the point person for the inspections and will coordinate all appointments for Mr. Baye.

Selectman Donovan made a motion to accept Tom Baye as the Life Safety Code Enforcement Officer; seconded by Chairman Johnson and approved.

Chairman Johnson nominated David MacAllen as an Alternate on the Planning Board, with Planning Board Chairman Jere Buckley's support; seconded by Selectman Donovan and approve. (No date was given, but his term would be until 2016).

Chairman Johnson nominated Colin Colby, who had expressed interest earlier in being a member of the Hazard Mitigation Committee; seconded by Selectman Donovan and approved. (No date was give, but this committee has no terms).

4:27 pm Selectman Donovan made a motion to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Chairman Johnson and approved.
