4:00 pm – Select Board’s Work Session – April 3, 2014

Chairman Fanjoy opened the meeting. All three Selectman were present. This was a work session to continue the discussion on roads from the last Select Board meeting. Also in attendance: Road Agent Emmett Bean, Sue Roberts, and Police Chief Dupuis.

Road Agent Emmett Bean shared that he has been working with the oil companies and that everything was working great. He suggested that the Select Board should leave the postings as is. The posting should be another two to three more weeks at the most.

Chief Dupuis shared that people need to realize the Police Department is only two and a half Officers, who are on the roads when they can be, but they cannot be on the road all of the time. He added that there needs to be some improvements in the process for next year, that the PD will not target anyone, and that there should be notification to people who are not cooperating with the Town.

Selectman Johnson shared that there is a difference between this year and last year. This year we are enforcing the ordinance to include oil companies. He shared the concern that if Webster residents need oil or propane that there is a way for them to get it.

Chairman Fanjoy shared the Concord ordinance, which allows for anyone who needs to deliver oil or propane to contact the road agent for a permit.

Selectman Donovan shared that the posting of roads is necessary for safety and road maintenance, and that there have been no problems to date, and that the current process of contacting the road agent to work out fuel delivery is working. Selectman Donovan made the motion to keep doing what we are doing right now, seconded by Selectman Johnson, and passed.

Chief Dupuis asked for Select Board input on whether or not to require stopped trucks to turn around. The Select Board supported this. The Chief will make the final decision. Selectman Johnson will help the Chief with a letter.

4:58 pm Selectman Donovan made a motion to close the meeting, seconded by Selectman Johnson, and passed. Meeting closed at.
