Select Board Meeting – December 3, 2014 Work Session

Select Board present: Chairman Roy Fanjoy, Selectman Bruce Johnson and Selectman Roger Becker and Leslie Palmer from Boscawen.

The Board signed two purchase orders:

- PO #41 for the Police Department to Mainstay Technologies for a firewall in the amount of \$4,754.41.
- PO #42 for the Fire Department to Bass Pro Shops for a GPS unit in the amount of \$461.59.

4:30 pm The Board met to discuss the Welfare Director's position with Ms. Palmer, currently the Welfare Director for the Town of Boscawen. Questions and answers were exchanged regarding how Webster handles welfare issues currently and welfare benefits in general.

Ms. Palmer will contact Barbara Chellis for additional information regarding how she handled Webster's needs and took the current Welfare Application for review. The Board will meet with her again on December 15, 2014 at 4:00 pm.

Discussed an e-mail from the Road Agent and needs he has to complete clean-up from the storm.

Chairman Fanjoy discussed glitches with the 911 reverse call he requested be sent out for emergency services in regards to the recent storm. This call went to Salisbury and Boscawen residents and did not reach all of Webster's residents. Discussed the possibility of combining services with other towns. Selectman Johnson will bring this up at the next Shared Services Meeting.

Chairman Fanjoy contacted Frank Anzalone this morning about the PSB contract. The bond approval is holding things up. The Board discussed the possibility and logistics of completing the project this year and the need for a signed contract should the funds need to be encumbered. The decision was to send the contract to Town Counsel for review as soon as received.

Selectman Johnson discussed the proposed swap shop at the landfill and his support of the project. The Board agreed to support this project and Selectman Johnson will contact Hopkinton and supporter Sally Embley to advise them of the Board's decision.

The Board discussed correspondence from Warner regarding the recent legal matter shared between the two towns and Warner's request as to how to respond to residents' inquiries. It was agreed that there was nothing further that could be done with no other decisions made.
