

Town of Webster Energy Committee  
Meeting Notes  
August 14, 2013

Attending: Chairman Marty Bender, Selectman Bruce Johnson, Police Chief Bob Dupuis, Member Jere Buckley as well as visitor and electrician Scott Swett and visitor and resident Wayne St. Jacques.

Mr. Buckley presented information from Unitil in regards to the lighting of the Memorial flagpole. The committee is presently waiting for more information on possible changes to residential charges and cost savings. Selectman Johnson to contact neighboring Selectmen concerning utility categories and rates. Chairman Bender to look into possible improvements at the Memorial flagpole site that might enhance the solar option. The goal is make a final decision about how to proceed at the next meeting.

Discussion with electrician Scott Swett concerning Town Hall outside lights and Salt Shed outside lights to configurations requiring less electrical usages and therefore cost savings. Mr. Swett to present a quote for the work. Will continue the discussion at the next meeting.

Safety Building lights. Chairman Bender and Chief Dupuis met with an energy specialist earlier in the day concerning changes in Safety Building lights to configurations requiring less electrical usages and cost savings. The consultant to present a written proposal for improvements. Will continue the discussion at the next meeting.

Safety Building Solar Power. Visitor and resident Wayne St. Jacques offered to review the ReVision proposal for quality, and to look into additional local companies that might be able to offer a similar proposal. The goal would be to make a decision about how to proceed by the next meeting, or the meeting afterwards, in order to take advantage of renewable energy incentives while still available.

Heating System. Chairman Bender to continue to look into the wood pellet furnaces, and to bring additional information to the next meeting.
