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Webster Board of Selectmen's Meeting – March 10, 2008

7:00 P.M. Roll Call – Selectmen present: George Hashem, David Klumb and Thomas Mullins.

The Board signed a Payroll Check Warrant and the Accounts Payable Warrant. Selectman Mullins made a motion to accept the February 11, 2008 minutes as revised, seconded by Selectman Klumb and so approved. Minor changes were recommended for the February 25, 2008 minutes to be approved at the next Meeting.

The Board signed the following for Administrative Assistant Judith Jones:

- Leave Slips for Mrs. Jones and Wendy Pinkham;
- Advance Notification of Tax Deeding for Tax Collector will be reviewed and signed later by the Board;
- A Letter to Tax Collector requesting she use Goulet Computer Consultant for the lien process;
- Advance Notification of Tax Deeding for Tax Collector which the Board will review and signed later;
- Abatement for Thomas Cuilla as he has deeded the parcel to the Town;
- Purchase Order #3 for the PD for \$1,000 deductible repair expense from the accident;
- Purchase Order #4 for the Town Hall in the amount of \$355.26 for supplies;
- License to Operate a Motor Vehicle Junk Yard for Webster Town Automotive Recycling; and
- An application for Veteran's Tax Credit was approved.

The Police Department has a lap top available that could be given to the Supervisors of the Checklist should the Board agree. It needs to be emptied of its contents, will require a new battery and needs to be made usable for the Supervisors needs. It may be cheaper to purchase a new lap top and this will be considered.

The Board reviewed the Purchase Policy. Selectman Klumb made a motion to accept the Policy as written to be effective immediately; seconded by Selectman Mullins and unanimously approved. Copies will be distributed to all Department Heads.

Road Agent Emmett Bean advised that he will most likely be posting the dirt roads soon and the tar roads shortly after that, but no later than March 17, 2008.

Police Chief Brian Milano presented his semi-monthly report.

Mrs. Jones provided a packet of information provided by Department of Revenue Representative Greg Heyn for the Board's review prior to Mr. Heyn attending the next Selectmen's Meeting.
