Webster Board of Selectmen's Meeting – October 20, 2008

7:00 P.M. Roll Call – Present: Chairman George Hashem, Selectman Thomas Mullins and Selectman David Klumb.

The Board signed the payroll check and vendor manifests.

Selectmen Klumb made a motion to accept the Selectmen's minutes of October 6, 2008 as written; seconded by Selectman Mullins and approved.

The Board signed the following for Administrative Assistant Judith Jones:

8:00 P.M. The Board met with Jeff Earles from Cross Country Appraisal Group, LLC; Mark Neider from Commerford, Nieder & Perkins, LLC and Christine Murdough from Assessing Services Unlimited. The Board is seeking an assessment company to fulfill the Town's assessing needs for the next five years. After each interview, the company representative was advised that the Board would make a decision by November 3, 2008.

Planning Board Chairman Cliff Broker had left a message noting concerns about water runoff on Hollings Drive, Dustin Road and Little Hill. Selectman Mullins is aware of these issues and has been reviewing them.

Chairman Hashem has prepared some revisions to the Personnel Policy, which will be reviewed later.

Most of the concerns raised by Jeremy Pendleton of Pearson Hill regarding the new pavement have been addressed by the Road Agent. There are still some large rocks remaining which could be removed once the ground is frozen.
