MEETING MINUTES THURSDAY JULY 20, 2023

1 The Planning Board held a meeting on Thursday, July 20, 2023. The meeting was held at the Town Hall 2 in the Grange Hall; 945 Battle Street, Webster, NH 03303. 3 4 Planning Board Members present: Chairperson Craig Fournier, Marlo Herrick, and Theresa Finnemore. 5 6 Also, present: Land Use Coordinator Russell Tatro. 7 8 Chairperson Fournier opened the meeting at 6:30pm by taking attendance Member Mock, Member King, 9 and Member Youngs were absent. He then asked if Alt. Member Finnemore would fill in for one of the 10 absent members and she agreed she would. He then moved the first item on the agenda, the Mutton Road 11 letter. 12 13 Chairperson Fournier informed the Board that he had drafted a letter to the property owner on Mutton 14 Road who he thought had planted the maple trees close to the road. He had provided a copy of the letter 15 for the Board to review. Member Herrick asked if they knew where exactly the Town's right of way on 16 Mutton Road is. Chairperson Fournier responded that due to the age of the Road it was difficult to 17 determine. Member Finnemore responded that she thought that the stone wall was the boundary marker. 18 Chairperson Fournier responded that he had done his own research and he could not come to a clear 19 conclusion of where the right ow way was. Chairperson Fournier then read aloud his letter. Member 20 Herrick stated that she was in favor of planning trees but understood that the Town needed to protect 21 itself. Chairperson Fournier reminded the Board that the Town had an obligation to make sure the right of 22 way was maintained and safe for passage. 23 24 Chairperson Fournier moved to the next item on the agenda, the Steele Driveway. 25 26 He asked the Board members present to give him an update on what happened at the site visit because he 27 had missed the site visit last month. The Board then updated Chairperson Fournier regarding what 28 happened at the site visit last month. 29 30 Chairperson Fournier then moved to the next item on the agenda, Future Zoning Discussion. 31 32 Chairperson Founier stated that he wanted to postpone the discussion until more members were present. 33 The Board agreed this made sense. 34 35 Chairperson Fournier moved to the next item on the agenda, Public Comment. 36 37 Coordinator Tatro informed the Board that Member King had been ill recently, and he hoped that the 38 Board would provide a member to review driveways during his recovery.
