Trustees Meeting

June 19, 2013

OLD BUSINESS

- Nancy read an email from Terry Knowles regarding the Baker and Taylor question. Cathryn researched the question with other librarians and Baker and Taylor and found that Baker and Taylor does offer a staff account with the same discount the library gets, but shipping is not free. Cathryn has set up the staff account.
- We discussed the NHLA use calculator and Cathryn will post it on the library website.
- Nancy drafted a flyer advertising the museum passes and left it at the elementary school to be distributed.
- There is no new information on the telescopes at this time.

NEW BUSINESS

- Carisa Corrow would like to start a fifth through eighth grade book discussion group for the summer. It was decided that the children would need library cards to ensure that all books are returned to the library. Cathryn sent a flyer for distribution to the elementary school and will post the information in the *Grapevine* as well as at the front desk.

- Kendra Saunders, a Webster resident, has just had a book accepted for publication. She would like to do a presentation at the library in October on how to get a book published. Since the trustees felt that the benefit for the library would be the talk, it was agreed that she could sell her book if she wished. Cathryn will advertise the talk in the *Grapevine* and the *Concord Monitor*.
- Baker and Taylor offers an online payment option. We need to find out if we can still have a paper copy for the files. Marty will check on this.
