Payment for The NH Farm Museum pass has been submitted. Cathryn called to check on its status and was told that it is in the mail. The Telephone Museum pass has been paid and is now available.

Nancy has a meeting with the WES principal on July 23<sup>rd</sup> @11:30 to talk about options for involving the kindergarten and elementary students.

Nancy has started collecting library pamphlets as exemplars for redesigning the one for WFPL. Her vision is to create one without lists and will submit her prototype to the trustees for their input.

Nancy contacted the Department of Environmental Services and scheduled a workshop, A Garden For Wildlife – Create A Haven For Wildlife, on March 26 from 2-3 p.m. and reserved the town hall for the same day from 1-4 p.m.

## **New Business**
