The meeting was called to order at 4:07. Present were Cathryn Clark-Dawe, Director, Nancy Picthall-French, President, Marty Bender, Treasurer, and Leslie Collins, Secretary.

The Secretary's report for July was reviewed and accepted after a lower case b was changed to an upper case.

The budget for September was reviewed and accepted.

Old Business

Nancy asked for an update on the status of the computers. Cathryn stated that four of the five computers have malfunctioned and the fifth one needs servicing. Marty has returned the computers to Best Buy. When he picks up computer #4, he will bring in computer #5 for servicing. Cathryn noticed that after updating Windows, the receipt printer no longer worked and Norton is having problems. Marty will look at them during his volunteer hours on Wednesday.

Marty was notified that we were unable to attend the citizen archivist workshop at Keene State College on September 24th because of full enrollment. Leslie exchanged the \$50 Wal-Mart gift card for 10 \$5 gift cards for the first 10 Baby Book Bags. Nancy contacted Michele Derby and discovered that the information reported regarding births is confidential. Nancy will try to find out more information from the Merrimack county clerk.

Nancy is going to request to be on the Select Board's agenda to inquire about an appropriate ingress/egress route for handicapped patrons through the town hall. Currently, metal chairs block the passageway.

Nancy would like to invite the Select Board to use the library for one of their Monday evening meetings.

As a participant of the MUSE group (Museums Sharing Experiences; a group of local historical societies, museums and libraries that meet regularly to plan upcoming events in the towns of Penacook, Warner, Hopkinton, New London, the Indian Museum and the Telephone Museum)), Dorothy Bourque from the Webster Historical Society asked the library to run a World War I book group. All agreed with enthusiasm. Cathryn has been talking to the other librarians in Warner and Hopkinton. The idea will be put on hold temporarily until Cathryn finds out what other towns decide they are doing. Perhaps a different book assigned to each town and then a culminating get together for discussion?

Nancy passed out information on an upcoming workshop presented by NHLTA, Personnel Management Workshop for Library Trustees.
